- 1. Pay for an Outreach/LatinX Coordinator full time position. This has made a huge difference with our highest population of students and parents (Spanish speakers mostly). This position needs to be full time as they will be busy translating, home visits, family engagement nights, making academic videos and mentoring students both in academics and behaviors. May push-in to classrooms to do group work if needed (\$60,000-TSSA)
- 2. Home Connections with parent resources to help with ELA and Math at home (translated materials so they are able to help their students). When a parent asks how they can help their student, school will have parent packet ready for each grade level based on essential standards. Need more than just Lexia and Zearn (Learning A Z in Spanish, letting parents know what resources we have available to them) (5000.00-Title I)
- 3. Supplies for monthly meet and greets based on academic home connection (4000.00-Title I)
- 4. Two family activity nights (Literacy and STEAM focus) (6000.00-Title I)
- 5. PBIS incentives (5000.00-TSSA)
